

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI ESTABLISHING THE 1962 MILLAGE RATE UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED IN THE 1962-1963 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the 1962-1963 Budget of the Town of West Miami has heretofore been adopted, and

WHEREAS, the 1962 real and personal property tax assessment rolls of the Town have been approved and certified by the Town Council, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the millage rate to produce the income in order to meet the requirements of the 1962-1963 Budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In order to provide funds to cover all appropriations set forth in the 1962-1963 Budget as provided in Ordinance No. 240, there shall be and there is hereby levied upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real and personal property in the Town of West Miami, a tax of 5 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for 1962 for the calendar year beginning January 1, 1962; and as provided by Ordinance No. 133 there is hereby levied thereupon a tax of 1 mill for the playground and recreation fund established by said ordinance.

Section 2. In the interest of the general welfare of the residents of the Town of West Miami, the second reading of this ordinance is hereby waived.
