

ORDINANCE NO. 242

ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 208 OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI WHICH PERMITTED MINORS 17 YEARS OR MORE IN AGE TO ENTER AND PLAY POOL OR BILLIARDS IN POOL OR BILLIARD PARLORS WHERE NO INTOXICATING BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AND NO GAMBLING PERMITTED UPON THE PREMISES.

WHEREAS it appears that Ordinance 208 of the Town of West Miami, entitled:

"ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI PROVIDING THAT MINORS 17 YEARS OR MORE IN AGE MAY ENTER AND PLAY POOL OR BILLIARDS IN THOSE POOL OR BILLIARD PARLORS WHERE NO BEER, WINE OR INTOXICATING BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AND WHERE NO GAMBLING DEVICE OR GAMING IMPLEMENT OR APPARATUS IS MAINTAINED UPON THE PREMISES, AND AMENDING PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith."


is in conflict with 849.06, Florida Statutes, 1961.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Ordinance 208 of the Town Council of the Town of West Miami, Florida, heretofore passed and adopted the 7th day of October 1957, be and is hereby repealed effective this date, March 6, 1963.
