

ORDINANCE NO. 246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WEST MIAMI AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 176 BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 4.9 BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR DELINQUENCY IN PAYMENT OF FEES FOR TOWN COLLECTION SERVICE.

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Town Council that the administration of the Town has encountered considerable difficulty in the collection of numerous accounts, and

WHEREAS, it appears that delinquencies in fees for Town collection services will continue unless a penalty is assessed against delinquent accounts,

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of West Miami, Florida:

Section 1. That Ordinance 176 be and is hereby amended by adding thereto as Section 4.9 the following:

"Section 4.9 PENALTY FOR DELINQUENCY IN PAYMENT OF FEES. All fees provided for by this Ordinance shall be paid within the calendar month in which billed and if not paid within such calendar month shall thereupon be deemed delinquent and shall remain delinquent until paid in full together with any penalties as hereinafter provided. Fees paid at any time during the calendar month following the month of billing shall be increased by a penalty of fifty cents (50¢); fees paid at any time during the second calendar month following the billing month shall be increased by a penalty of One Dollar (\$1.00); and fees paid in any calendar month thereafter shall be increased by an amount equal to fifty cents (50¢) times the number of calendar months, or portions thereof, following the billing month."

Section 2. This amendment shall take effect as of

July 1, 1963.
