

ORDINANCE NO. 283

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY
OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, BY AMENDING
SECTIONS 11-6 AND 11-7 TO CHANGE THE
TERM AND DURATION OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Chapter 11 of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida, be and is hereby amended by changing Section 11-6 and Section 11-7, to read as follows:

"Sec. 11-6. Term and duration of license.
Any licenses issued under this chapter shall expire on the 30th day of September of each year. No license shall be issued for more than one year."

"Sec. 11-7. License for fractional part of one year. For the license period April 1, 1967 through September 30, 1967 one-half the full tax for one year shall be paid. Thereafter, the full tax for one year shall be paid for each license obtained between October 1, and March 31 of the following year; and for each license obtained between April 1, and September 30, one-half the full tax for one year shall be paid."

Section 2. If any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be invalid or inoperative, or shall be held by any Court to be unconstitutional, the remainder of the Ordinance shall nevertheless continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective April 1, 1967.
