

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA, RELATING TO TAX ON CIGARETTES
AND AMENDING SECTION 22-1(1) OF THE
WEST MIAMI CODE PERTAINING THERETO

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST
MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 22-1(1) of the West Miami Code be and is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec.22-1. Cigarette tax-levy.

An excise or privilege tax in addition to all
other taxes of every kind imposed by law is here-
by levied and imposed upon the sale, receipt, pur-
chase, possession, consumption, handling, distribu-
tion and use of cigarettes in the territorial limits
of the city for cigarettes of standard dimensions as
defined by the general law of the state in the follow-
ing amounts:


- (1)(a) Upon all cigarettes, as herein defined, four
inches long or less, four mills on each
cigarette;
- (b) Upon all cigarettes, as herein defined, more
than four inches long and not more than six
inches long, eight mills on each cigarette;
- (c) Upon all cigarettes, as herein defined, more
than six inches long, sixteen mills on each
cigarette. * * * * *

Section 2. It is the intent of the Council and it is so enacted
that this Ordinance shall be incorporated into the City Code and to
this effect the sections hereof may be renumbered and relettered.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect January 18, 1968.

Section 4. In the interest of the general welfare of the City
of West Miami, the second reading of this Ordinance is hereby waived.
