

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTIONS 24-23.1
AND 24-24 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, BY PROVIDING FOR
AND INCREASING SERVICE FEES FOR DIS-
CONTINUING AND RESTORING WATER SERVICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Sections 24-23.1 and 24-24 of the Code
of the City of West Miami be and are hereby amended to read as
follows:

"Sec. 24-23.1. Temporary and permanent discontinuance
of service to water customer.

(a) Upon request of any water customer and the payment
of a fee of two dollars (\$2.00), the city will discon-
tinue water service to such customer on a temporary
basis but will continue to retain the water deposit of
such customer pending restoration of service, or,
notice from the customer of final termination of ser-
vice. A bill for water service from the commencement
of the billing period to the date of discontinuance
of service will be rendered the customer; and such bill
shall be for water actually consumed during the billing
period notwithstanding the minimum charge hereinabove
provided. Upon 48-hour notice and payment of a further
fee of two dollars (\$2.00) the city will restore water
service to any customer whose service was temporarily
discontinued upon request as provided above. Upon
restoration of service the city shall bill the water
customer for water actually consumed during such billing
period notwithstanding the minimum charge hereinabove
provided.

(b) Upon request of any water customer and the payment
of a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) the city will discon-
tinue water service to such customer and will bill the
customer for water service to the date of discontinuance.
Upon the payment of a fee of two dollars (\$2.00), and
required deposit if a different or new water customer,
the city will restore water service to location where
discontinued, provided that all charges and fees due
for water service to such location have been paid in full."

* * * * *

"Sec. 24-24. Delinquency; discontinuance of service; reconnection charge.

(a) If any bill for water service shall be and remain due and unpaid on or after thirty-five (35) days from the date of said bill for water service, a delinquency penalty of fifty cents (50¢) shall be charged and added to such bill.


(b) If any bill for water service shall be and remain due and unpaid on or after twenty (20) days from the date of said bill for water service, the water service to such customer so in arrears may be discontinued without notice, and must be turned off after sixty (60) days. In the event service is discontinued for nonpayment of the bill for water service, the unpaid bill must be paid in full prior to service being resumed, together with service fee of two dollars (\$2.00) for discontinuing water service. In addition, a service charge of two dollars (\$2.00) must be paid at the same time to reimburse the city for its expense in connection with resuming service."

Section 2. It is intended that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision contained herein is held invalid the remainder shall not be affected.

Section 3. It is the intention of the City Council and it is hereby enacted, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida, and that sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 1970.
