

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE 1970 MILL-
AGE RATE UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL
PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS FOR
THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED
IN THE 1970-1971 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the 1970-1971 Budget of the City of West Miami, Florida, has heretofore been adopted; and

WHEREAS, the 1970 real and personal property tax assessment rolls of property within the City have been tentatively approved by the Metropolitan Dade County Tax Assessor and County Commission; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the millage rate to produce the income in order to meet the requirements of the 1970-1971 Budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In order to provide funds to cover all appropriations set forth in the 1970-1971 Budget as provided in Ordinance No. 313, there shall be and there is hereby levied upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real and personal property in the City of West Miami, a tax of 3.37 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for 1970 for the calendar year beginning January 1, 1970; and as provided by Ordinance 133 there is hereby levied thereupon a tax of .67 mills for the playground and recreation fund established by said ordinance.

Section 2. In the interest of the general welfare of the residents of the City of West Miami, the second reading of this ordinance is hereby waived.
