

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA, REPEALING CERTAIN SECTIONS
OF CHAPTER 3, CODE OF THE CITY OF
WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO
ISSUANCE AND TRANSFER OF LICENSES OF
VENDORS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND
IMPOSITION OF MUNICIPAL LICENSE TAXES
THEREFOR; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI,
FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the following sections of Chapter 3, Code
of the City of West Miami, Florida entitled "Alcoholic Beverages"
be and are hereby repealed:

- Sec. 3-2. Persons not entitled to license.
- Sec. 3-3. License applications.
- Sec. 3-4. License investigation.
- Sec. 3-5. License issuance.
- Sec. 3-6. Review of disapproved application.
- Sec. 3-7. Term of licenses.
- Sec. 3-8. Renewing license without approval.
- Sec. 3-9. Transfer of licenses.
- Sec. 3-10. Licensee moving to new location.
- Sec. 3-15. License fees for vendors.
- Sec. 3-16. License fees for manufacturers, dis-
tributors, brewers, rectifiers or
blenders.
- Sec. 3-17. No exemptions from license tax.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on the
1st day of December, 1971.
