ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING CHANGE IN STATE OF FLORIDA AGREE-
MENT WITH FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION
TO EXCLUDE EMPLOYEES IN PART-TIME POSITIONS FROM
SOCIAL SECURITY COVERAGE; DEFINING PART-TIME
POSITIONS; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHANGE;
AND DECLARING ORDINANCE TO BE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Department of Administration of the State of Florida has advised the City that the City may authorize the State to amend its agreement with the Federal Social Security Administration to exclude employees in part-time positions with the City of West Miami from Social Security coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance must be passed and a copy sent to the State before December 16, 1973; and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient time to enact the Ordinance other than as an emergency Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the City, by this Ordinance, does hereby authorize the Department of Administration of the State of Florida to amend the State's agreement with the Federal Social Security Administration of the United States to exclude employees holding part-time positions with the City of West Miami from coverage under the Federal Social Security Act effective January 1, 1974.


Section 2. As used herein the term "part-time position" shall mean one which does not normally require more than five hundred (500) hours work in any twelve (12) month period.

Section 3. By reason of the matter set forth herein a second reading of this Ordinance is hereby waived and this Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
