

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA,
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 344 WHICH EXCLUDED
PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FROM SOCIAL SECURITY
COVERAGE.

WHEREAS, on November 21, 1973, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 344 as an Emergency Ordinance, said Ordinance excluding Part-Time Employees of the City from Social Security coverage; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the passage of said ordinance would create many problems in connection with the City's participation in the State of Florida Retirement System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Ordinance 344 entitled "ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CHANGE IN STATE OF FLORIDA AGREEMENT WITH FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION TO EXCLUDE EMPLOYEES IN PART-TIME POSITIONS FROM SOCIAL SECURITY COVERAGE; DEFINING PART-TIME POSITIONS; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHANGE; AND DECLARING ORDINANCE TO BE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE," be and is hereby repealed.

Section 2. By reason of the matters set forth herein a second reading of this Ordinance is hereby waived and this Ordinance is hereby passed as an Emergency Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
