

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA AMENDING SECTION 3-14 (a) OF THE CITY CODE TO REMOVE BONA FIDE PHARMACIES AND BONA FIDE FLORISTS FROM EXCEPTIONS TO DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS BETWEEN VENDORS OF BEER AND WINE FOR OFF-PREMISE CONSUMPTION; EXPRESSING INTENT OF SEPARABILITY; PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 3-14 (a) of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 3-14. Exceptions to distance requirements.

(a) The limitations provided in Section 3-12 shall not apply to vendors of beverages containing alcohol of more than one percent by weight and not more than fourteen percent by weight and wines regardless of alcoholic content for consumption off the premises only and classified under Section 3-15 (b), where such vendor is licensed by the city as a bona fide food market or bona fide grocery store."


Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed 60 days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day's violation shall be deemed and considered to be a separate violation hereof and punishable as such.

Section 3. It is intended that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision contained herein is held invalid the remainder shall not be affected.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect July 5, 1974.

Section 5. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby enacted, that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida, and that sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.
