

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA,
ESTABLISHING THE 1974 MILLAGE RATE UPON ALL
REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY
LIMITS FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT APPRO-
PRIATED IN THE 1974-1975 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the 1974-1975 Budget of the City of West
Miami, Florida, has been approved; and

WHEREAS, the 1974 real and personal property tax
assessment rolls of property within the city have been published
by the Metropolitan Dade County Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the millage rate
to produce the income in order to meet the requirements of the
1974-1975 Budget; and

WHEREAS, Notice of Ad Valorem Tax Levy was duly pub-
lished as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In order to provide funds to cover all ap-
propriations set forth in the 1974-1975 Budget of the City, there
shall be and there is hereby levied upon the assessed valuation
of all taxable real and personal property in the City of West
Miami, a tax of \$5.286 per each \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation
as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for
1974 for the calendar year beginning January 1, 1974; and as pro-
vided by Ordinance 133 there is hereby levied thereupon a tax of
\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 valuation for the playground and recreation
fund established by said ordinance.


