

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, ADDING SECTION 10-10 TO THE CITY CODE REQUIRING HOTEL AND MOTEL EMPLOYEES TO HAVE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO BE ISSUED BY THE CITY; PRESCRIBING PROCEDURES AND COST FOR APPLICATION AND ISSUANCE OF CARDS; PROVIDING TERM OF CARD; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE; EXPRESSING INTENT OF SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; EXPRESSING INTENT THAT ORDINANCE BE INCLUDED IN THE CITY CODE; AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby created and added as Section 10-10 of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida, the following:

"Sec. 10-10. Hotel and motel employee's identification card.

(a) All persons including partners, officers, and directors, employed in or carrying on their duties or endeavors connected therewith in a hotel or motel located in the City of West Miami, shall apply to the Office of the Mayor for a hotel and motel employee's identification card within five (5) days from the date of their employment. It shall be unlawful for any such person to remain so employed without applying for an identification card.

(b) Application for a hotel and motel employee's identification card shall be made in writing to the Office of the Mayor and shall be accompanied by an application fee of two dollars (\$2.00), which shall be utilized to defray the cost of enforcement of this section. The application forms shall require the applicant to be fingerprinted and photographed. The Office of the Mayor shall issue an identification card within ten (10) days from the date of such application.

(c) All identification cards issued pursuant to this section shall be serially numbered and shall bear the date of issuance, the applicant's name, home address, birth date, physical description, full-face photograph, social security number, and shall be signed by the holder.

(d) The police department of the City shall maintain a suitable file of all identification cards issued pursuant to this section. Such records shall contain a copy of the identification card, together with the application therefor.

(e) All identification cards issued under this section shall expire three (3) years from the date of issue."


Section 2. Should any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance be declared and adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate or fail to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined by a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, or imprisoned for not more than sixty (60) days, or both, in the discretion of the Judge of the City Court. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. Because of the content and nature of this ordinance it shall be included in and made a part of the City Code.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect July 1, 1975.
