

ORDINANCE NO. 369

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, IMPOSING A SERVICE FEE OF FIVE DOLLARS FOR THE COLLECTION OF A DISHONORED CHECK, DRAFT, OR OTHER ORDER FOR THE PAYMENT OF MONEY TO THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR DEPOSIT OF THE FEES COLLECTED TO THE SAME FUND AS THE COLLECTED ITEM; EXPRESSING INTENT THAT ORDINANCE BE INCLUDED IN THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Whenever any check, draft or other order for the payment of money to the City of West Miami is returned for any reason by the bank or other payor upon which the same shall have been drawn, it shall be the duty of the Mayor to collect same and to add a Five Dollar (\$5.00) Service Fee to the amount due. The \$5.00 Service Fee shall be in addition to all other penalties imposed by law.

Section 2. The Service Fees collected shall be deposited in the same fund as the collected item.

Section 3. It is intended that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision contained herein is held invalid the remainder shall not be affected.

Section 4. It is the intention of the City Council and it is hereby enacted that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of West Miami, Florida and that sections of this Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect October 16, 1975.
