

ORDINANCE NO. 372

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA
ESTABLISHING THE 1976 MILLAGE RATE UPON ALL
REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY
LIMITS FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS APPROPRI-
ATED IN THE 1976-1977 BUDGETS

WHEREAS, the 1976-1977 budgets of the City of West Miami,
Florida, have been approved; and


WHEREAS, the 1976 real and personal property tax assess-
ment rolls of property within the City have been published by
the Metropolitan Dade County Property Appraiser; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the millage rate
to produce the income in order to meet the requirements of
the 1976-1977 budgets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In order to provide funds to cover all
appropriations set forth in the 1976-1977 budgets of the
City, there shall be and there is hereby levied upon the
assessed valuation of all taxable real and personal property
in the City of West Miami, a tax of \$6.50 per each \$1,000.00
of assessed valuation as shown on the real and personal
property assessment rolls for 1976 for the calendar year
beginning January 1, 1976; and as provided by Ordinance 133
there is hereby levied thereupon a tax of \$1.00 per \$1,000.00
valuation for the playground and recreation fund established
by said ordinance.
