

ORDINANCE # 90-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBSECTIONS (a) (b) OF SECTION 15-48, SCHEDULE OF RATES, OF ARTICLE III, RATES AND CHARGES, BY INCREASING THE CHARGE TO ONE DOLLAR AND TWENTY CENTS (\$1.20) PER ONE HUNDRED (100) CUBIC FEET IN EXCESS OF ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (1,500) CUBIC FEET FOR WATER FURNISHED IN A QUARTERLY PERIOD, COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1990; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

W/A WASA HAS INCREASED THE H₂O RATES,
Section 1. That Subsection (a) (b) of Section 15-48,

Schedule of Rates, of Article III, Rates and Charges, of the Code of the City of West Miami be amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

Sec. 15-48. Schedule of Rates.

There is hereby established the following schedule of rates and charges for services rendered by the municipal water distribution system of the City.

- (a) A minimum charge of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for water furnished in a quarterly billing period not to exceed one thousand five hundred (1,500) cubic feet;
- (b) A charge of One Dollar and Twenty Cents (\$1.20) per one hundred (100) cubic feet in excess of one thousand five hundred (1,500) cubic feet for water furnished in a quarterly billing period commencing on October 1, 1990.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any


court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. It is the intention of the City Council that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of West Miami; and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately at the time of its passage.
