

ORDINANCE NO. 94-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 11-2, ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 11 OF THE WEST MIAMI CODE BY AMENDING SUB-PARAGRAPH (d) PROVIDING FOR NON-RESIDENT ANNUAL FEES FOR THE USE OF THE RECREATION CENTER, 1700 S. W. 62 AVENUE, WEST MIAMI, ARE FOR CHILDREN, AGES 6 TO 12, \$100.00 FOR ONE CHILD; \$140.00 FOR TWO CHILDREN; \$200.00 FOR MORE THAN TWO CHILDREN; AND FOR CHILDREN 12 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER, THE FEES ARE \$50.00 FOR ONE CHILD; \$70.00 FOR TWO CHILDREN; \$100.00 FOR OVER TWO CHILDREN; THE CITY COMMISSION MAY, BY RESOLUTION, ALLOW INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS FOR HARDSHIP CASES; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA,

Section 1. That Section 11-2, Article 1, Chapter 11, Sub-sub-paragraph (d) of the West Miami Code be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11-2(d). Non-residents of the City shall pay the City an annual fee due on the 1st of October of each year for the use of the Recreation Center located at 1700 S. W. 62 Avenue, West Miami, Florida, as follows:

Ages 6-12 years - \$100.00 for one child per year;
\$140.00 for two children per year; and
\$200.00 for family participation of
more than two children within this age
group, per year;

Ages 12 and older - \$50.00 for one child per year;
\$70.00 for two children per year; and

\$100.00 for family participation of more than two children within this age group, per year.

Section 2. The City Commissioners may, by resolution, allow installment payments for hardship cases.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.


Section 4. If any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected, but shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of West Miami Code; and that the sections of this Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.


