



RESOLUTION # 2015-46

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE 2015 TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATES UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED IN THE 2015-2016 TENTATIVE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, The 2015 Real and Personal Property Tax assessment rolls of property within the City have been certified by the Metropolitan Dade County Property Appraiser as provided in F.S. 200.065; and

WHEREAS, The tentative budgets of the City of West Miami, Florida, have been submitted; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to establish the final millage rate to produce the income in order to meet the requirements of the amended 2015-2016 budgets as provided in F.S. 200.065;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The aforementioned statements are true and correct and adopted as is fully stated herein.

Section 2. In order to provide funds to cover all appropriations set forth in the 2015-2016 tentative budget of the City, there shall be and there is hereby proposed to be levied upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real and personal property in the City of West Miami, a tax of \$5.8858 per each \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for 2015 for the calendar year beginning January 1st, 2016; and, as provided by Ordinance 133 as codified in sub-section 11-2 of the West Miami Code, and there is hereby proposed to levy thereupon a tax of \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 valuation for the playground and Recreation Fund established by said Ordinance. **For a total combined millage rate of \$6.8858.**

Section 3. Pursuant to F.S. 200.065 (2)(d), the City Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the Final Budget and proposed millage rate at City Hall, 901 SW 62 AVE, West Miami, FL 33144 on September 23rd, 2015, at 7:30 P.M. at the West Miami Commission Chambers, 2nd Floor.

Section 4. The said millage rate to be levied increases the roll back rate by 10.1675 % percent, resulting in an increase in property taxes by said percentage.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.
