RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO BORROW A CAP OF \$ 1.5 million FOR HURRICANE IRMA STORM RELATED DAMAGE AND DEBRIS REMOVAL CITY WIDE; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, by reason of Hurricane Irma, the City of West Miami has become a disaster area and in need of emergency funds for damages sustained as a result of said hurricane; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), has agreed to reimburse local governments for emergency funds for repairs, replacements and other restoration expenditures caused by Hurricane Irma and its aftermath; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami is unable to expend its own funds for such relief work without obtaining a credit line for such expenditures until reimbursed by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the City is a disaster area resulting from said hurricane,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The City of West Miami be and is hereby declared a disaster area as the result of Hurricane Irma.

Section 2. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized to procure a credit line with a cap of \$ 1.5 million for a term of one Year at the lowest interest rate available.

Section 3. Any credit draw balance shall be repaid immediately upon receipt of funds from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective on September 15th, 2017.
