RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH All Florida Land Clearing IN CONNECTION WITH HURRICANE IRMA STORM RELATED DAMAGE AND DEBRIS REMOVAL CITY WIDE PURSUANT TO RFP NUMBER 201709112017 SPECIFICATIONS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by reason of Hurricane Irma, the City of West Miami has become a disaster area and in need of repairs, replacements and other restoration expenditures caused by Hurricane Irma and its aftermath; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the City is a disaster area resulting from said hurricane, and

WHEREAS, The City of West Miami is solicited proposals for tree trimming of hanging tree limbs damaged from Hurricane Irma, removal of storm related debris, removal of tree trunk under two (2') in diameter from non-viable trees and hauling to a FEMA approved site and for disposal of the storm related debris in accordance with State of Florida requirements on September 12, 2017, City Wide, at 901 SW 62 Avenue, West Miami, Florida, providing for all materials, labor, tools and equipment to accomplish the work, pursuant to the terms and conditions in a form contract.

WHEREAS, the proposal from All Florida Land Clearing to achieve the intended purpose in the amount of \$38.00 PER CUBIC YARDS (\$) has been found to be acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Public Works Director have recommended the acceptance of the above referenced proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The City of West Miami be and is hereby declared a disaster area as the result of Hurricane Irma.

Section 2. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized to execute a contract with _____ for the purpose of tree trimming of hanging tree limbs damaged from Hurricane Irma, removal of storm related debris, removal of tree trunk under two (2') in diameter from non-viable trees and hauling to a FEMA approved site and for disposal of the storm related debris in accordance with State of Florida requirements on September 12, 2017, City Wide, at 901 SW 62 Avenue, West Miami, Florida, providing for all materials, labor, tools and equipment to accomplish the work, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the contract.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.
