



**RESOLUTION # 2020-05**

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REPORT OF THE CITY MANAGER PERTAINING TO THE GROUP LIFE INSURANCE FOR ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES AND CITY OFFICIALS, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL BY THE HARTFORD INSURANCE COMPANY WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2020 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup> 2020 TO COINCIDE WITH THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR, YEAR TWO COMMENCING OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup> 2021 PRESERVING THE SAME RATE STRUCTURE AND COVERAGES FOR THE THREE RECOGNIZED CLASSES LABELED AS CLASS 1, CLASS 2 AND CLASS 3; PROVIDING FOR A TWENTY-NINE MONTHS RATE GUARANTEE; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Due to the expected 14% rate increase from Mutual of Omaha and in an effort to find viable alternatives the Office of the City Manager requested from our insurance brokers to shop for a comparable insurance company with the same level of coverage as a way to seek competitive pricing and allow a procurement process for the City's Life Insurance Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Hartford Life Insurance Company has proposed to insure all eligible classes known as Class 1, 2 and 3 with same level of coverage and has proposed to honor the rates that were in effect through December 30<sup>th</sup> 2019 by Mutual of Omaha; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Manager hereby recommends the ratification the life insurance coverage with The Hartford Insurance Company to include a two-year rate guarantee for all eligible members with an effective date of March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami that:

SECTION 1. The aforementioned statements are true and correct and adopted as is fully stated herein.




