RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AMENDING RESOLUTION 2019-40 BY ADDING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE RESTROOM AT GARDEN CLUB PARK LOCATED AT 6585 SW 12 STREET, WEST MIAMI FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF STAFF; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000.00 PROVIDING, SAID FUNDS ALLOCATED IN THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI APPROVED 2019-2020 GENERAL FUNDS, PARKS DIVISION ACCOUNT#575-600, PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined the need to complete the Garden Club Park Project by constructing the final phase of the project which consists of restroom facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends an extension to the change order awarded to Conbuild LLC presently working on the City Hall Passport and Restroom addition renovations in an effort to complete a long overdue final phase of this project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineers and staff have reviewed the proposal and are recommending to advance it for approval by the Mayor and City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the funds were budgeted in the City of West Miami General Funds, Parks Division account #575-600 (coming in from Parks Impact Fees); and

WHEREAS, the Administration found that the change order falls within the funding allocated for the completion of the Garden Club Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby amended being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The City Commission accepts and approves the recommendation of the Administration to for the approval of a change order by Conbuild LLC in the amount of \$40,000.00.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all contract documents with Conbuild, LLC for the Change Order. See attached proposal marked as an Exhibit to the Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.
