



RESOLUTION # 2024-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING FROM 7 P.M. TO 7 A.M. ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SW 9TH STREET BETWEEN SW 62ND AVENUE AND SW 64TH AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the basic purpose to support traffic on streets within the City of West Miami is to balance the use of limited parking spaces to prevent motorists from blocking access to properties and to prevent possible traffic congestion, and

WHEREAS, the present congestion of the afore-mentioned area has been reported by citizens and observed by Code Enforcement officers, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has found it necessary to establish control of the parking spaces in the above-described areas to promote the safety and welfare of the residents of the City of West Miami.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2: Parking in the north side of 9th Street between SW 62nd Avenue and SW 64th Avenue shall be prohibited from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. every day.

Section 3: A violation of this resolution shall result in a fine of \$_____ for each occurrence.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


