**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A RESIDUAL GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE GRANTS, FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, REFERENCE JAG21 – COUNTYWIDE RESIDUAL FUNDING REQUESTED BY THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT ON OR ABOUT SEPTEMBER 11, 2023 IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY-THREE NEW LAPTOP COMPUTERS AND SOFTWARE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami Police Department is currently using laptops that are 6 years old and have become ineffective due to prolonged field exposure, vehicle vibration, weather and increased heat indexes; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the City's growth in population over the past five (5) years, the police department has experienced an increase in calls for service, report calls and written reports; and

**WHEREAS**, the police department is in need to replace said laptops and software in order to maintain an adequate services to the citizens of the City of West Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Chief of the City of West Miami has requested residual funding in the amount of \$ 80,000.00 for the purchase of twenty-three (23) new semi- rugged laptops which are rated to withstand all elements of field use both in a patrol and criminal investigations environment, including related software for patrol and investigations field use.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI THAT:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing "whereas" clauses and heading are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

**Section 2.** The City Commission hereby accepts the residual grant from the office of Criminal Justice Grants, Florida Department of Law Enforcement.

**Section 3.** The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documents to effectuate the acceptance of the JAG21 Countywide Residual Funding Grant in the amount of \$80,000.00.

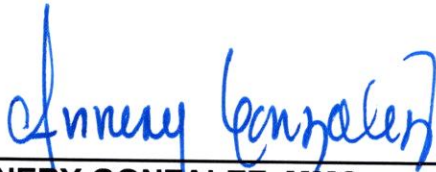
**Section 4.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.
