



RESOLUTION # 2024-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI REQUIRING AUTHORIZATION OF THE MIAMI-DADE ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 100.151, TO SUBMIT ON THE BALLOT FOR THE NOVEMBER 5TH, 2024 COUNTYWIDE GENERAL ELECTIONS CERTAIN CHARTER AMENDMENT QUESTION(S); PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami is vested with the authority to propose amendments to its Charter for consideration by the electorate; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 100.151 requires that certain charter amendment questions be submitted to the electorate through the Miami-Dade Elections Department Supervisor of Elections; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami have determined it necessary and prudent to propose certain charter amendments for consideration by the voters during the November 5th, 2024 Countywide General Elections; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami desires to formally request authorization from the Miami-Dade Elections Department Supervisor of Elections to include said charter amendment questions on the ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Commission hereby request authorization from the Miami-Dade Elections Department Supervisor of Elections, pursuant to Florida Statute 100.151, to submit certain charter amendment questions on the ballot for the November 5th, 2024 Countywide General Elections.

Section 3. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Miami-Dade Elections Department Supervisor of Elections forthwith.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.


