



RESOLUTION # 2024-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI RELATED TO PROCUREMENT, CONTINUING TO UTILIZE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND V & G CONSTRUCTION SOLUTIONS, CORP. EXECUTED ON DECEMBER 21ST, 2023 TO PROVIDE “CITY-WIDE TRAFFIC CALMING INSTALLATION DEVICES” IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$60,000.00) AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commission approved the procurement process on November 29, 2023 during a Regular Commission Meeting for “City-Wide Traffic Calming Devices”; and

WHEREAS, the Commission approved V & G Construction Solutions, Corp to install calming devices throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, residents have submitted new requests to fulfill; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2: The City Commission hereby accepts the continuing contract of V & G Construction Solutions, Corp, to fulfill the requests received by City residents.

Section 3: The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to generate a purchase order in the amount of Sixty-Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$ 60,000.00) with V & G Construction Solutions, Corp.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


