



RESOLUTION # 2024-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CITY TRANSIT SERVICES; ADOPTING A CITY SYSTEM SAFETY PROGRAM PLAN (SSPP) AND A SECURITY PROGRAM PLAN (SPP) FOR THE TRANSIT DIVISION TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) DISTRICT 6 OFFICE OF MODAL DEVELOPMENT FOR RECIPIENTS OF STATE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FUNDING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2020, the City became a recipient to Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) grant funding in the amount of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to promote and enhance the transportation system within the City, approved via Resolution 2021-05; and

WHEREAS, funding received was used for on-demand transit services contracted to Freebee via Resolutions 2021-39 and Resolution 2022-09; and

WHEREAS, in December of 2021, staff was made aware of the Triennial Review requirement to be in compliance with the Public Transit requirement of Chapter 341, Florida Statutes and the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 14-90; and

WHEREAS, October 2022, the review was conducted with staff along with Freebee to check vehicles, review policies and provide documentation; and

WHEREAS, in January 2023, staff received feedback as a report of findings along with a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to provide responses and a plan to address deficiencies; and

WHEREAS, to fulfill requirements and remain in compliance to continue eligibility for FDOT grant programs, staff requests Commission adopt the System Safety Program Plan (SSPP) and Security Program Plan (SPP).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.

Section 1: The City Commission hereby adopts the System Safety Program Plan (SSPP) to fulfill grant requirements and remain in compliance and eligible for funding.

Section 2: The City Commission hereby adopts the Security Program Plan (SPP) to fulfill grant requirements and remain in compliance and eligible for funding.

Section 3: The resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


